### **II<sup>nd</sup> SUNDAY OF ADVENT**

Today's Gospel and last week's are taken from the Gospel of Mark, the earliest of the Gospels. In it we encounter Jesus who came to understand his pivotal role in the salvation of the world and in his mission to bring the Good News of God's reign to all of creation. In today's Gospel, John the Baptist anticipates the coming of the Messiah. He proclaims a baptism with water for the forgiveness of sins, while attesting to his belief that the one who is to come after him will offer a baptism in the Holy Spirit that will provide the pathway to salvation. Advent is a season charged with anticipation – when we are acutely aware of the promise made by Jesus our Messiah that he will return to us. While we await his return, our preparation consists of participating in Jesus' mission of furthering God's reign. We are his missionary disciples who feed the hungry, clothe the naked, give drink to those who thirst, house the homeless, care for creation and work for justice, all the while proclaiming that Jesus is Lord. This season of Advent is a gift to us. It is an opportunity to invite Jesus into our lives anew and to reflect on what our baptism by water and the Holy Spirit requires of us.

### **From the new encyclical FRATELLI TUTTI, Pope Francis /Dalla nuova enciclica FRATELLI TUTTI, Papa Francesco**

*Continuation.....* In chapter seven, he discussed the conditions for peace and reconciliation, deploring the injustices of war and calling for an end to the use of the death penalty worldwide. He noted that the Catechism of the Catholic Church recognizes the possibility of legitimate defense by military force. But he said this was often interpreted too broadly, arguing that “it is very difficult nowadays to invoke the rational criteria elaborated in earlier centuries to speak of the possibility of a ‘just war.’” An accompanying footnote said: “St. Augustine, who forged a concept of ‘just war’ that we no longer uphold in our own day, also said that ‘it is a higher glory still to stay war itself with a word, than to slay men with the sword, and to procure or maintain peace by peace, not by war.’” The pope appealed to governments to give money allocated to weapons to “a global fund that can finally put an end to hunger and favor development in the most impoverished countries.” He also emphasized that the death penalty today is “inadmissible,” recalling his 2018 change to the Catechism’s teaching on the topic. *(to be continued...)*

*Continuazione.....* Nel settimo capitolo ha discusso le condizioni per la pace e la riconciliazione, deplorando le ingiustizie della guerra e chiedendo la fine dell'uso della pena di morte in tutto il mondo. Ha osservato che il Catechismo della Chiesa Cattolica riconosce la possibilità di una legittima difesa con la forza militare. Ma ha detto che questo è stato spesso interpretato in modo troppo ampio, sostenendo che “è molto difficile al giorno d'oggi invocare i criteri razionali elaborati nei secoli precedenti per parlare della possibilità di una 'guerra giusta'”. Una nota di accompagnamento, ha detto: “S. Agostino, che ha forgiato un concetto di “ guerra giusta ” che non sosteniamo più ai nostri giorni, ha anche detto che “ è una gloria ancora più alta rimanere la guerra stessa con una parola, che uccidere gli uomini con la spada e procurarsi o mantenere la pace con la pace, non con la guerra. ” Il papa ha fatto appello ai governi affinché diano i soldi stanziati per le armi a “un fondo globale che possa finalmente porre fine alla fame e favorire lo sviluppo nei Paesi più poveri”. Ha anche sottolineato che la pena di morte oggi è “inammissibile”, ricordando la sua modifica del 2018 all'insegnamento del Catechismo sull'argomento. *(continua.....)*

### **Archbishop Smith: We have hope that is real**

Archbishop Smith writes that it's been said, and perhaps you have heard it too, that the only thing worse than being lost or left behind is the feeling that no one is coming to look for you. Jesus continues to stretch out his arm to us in rescue. The pandemic has left many people experiencing a sense of helplessness, of being ensnared by circumstances too powerful to control. The feeling of isolation is widespread, or of being caught with no way out. This circumstance brings us to the realization that the reason for hope lies not within ourselves. It is found in the One in whose view each of us is precious, who will always come looking, and who has the power to rescue.

# Letter from the Catholic Bishops of Alberta and the Northwest Territories

December 2, 2020

Dear Faithful in Christ,

Is it okay for a Catholic to be vaccinated against COVID-19? The short answer is: Yes, it is.

Reading this, many people might be surprised that the question is even being posed. What could be wrong about receiving a vaccine, when we know that vaccinations save lives? The Catholic Church does certainly support and encourage ethical scientific research into the development of vaccines that will mitigate or even end the harm caused by this terrible disease. The virus is linked with the death to date of more than one million people and has caused great harm to millions more.

The moral issue arises from the fact that vaccine development and testing often make use of cell lines derived from either the tissue of aborted fetuses or destroyed human embryos. Therefore, reception of a vaccine developed and produced from this unethical research presents us with a dilemma that seriously engages our conscience. On the one hand, we know that widespread vaccination is a public health imperative to keep ourselves, our families and other citizens safe; on the other, we worry that receiving the vaccine would render us complicit in the moral evil of abortion, and thus unfaithful to the teaching of the Church on the sanctity of life.

Making use of abortion to create cell lines for research and development is an affront to human dignity and cannot be morally justified. Sadly, such cell lines are so widely used in the biopharmaceutical industry that a vaccine that has not been ethically compromised in its production and/or testing by their use may very well not be available for employment against COVID-19. Doctors and families should normally seek out ethically acceptable vaccines. When this is not possible, then there arises the specific question we address in this letter: in the midst of a pandemic that poses a serious threat to public health, is it morally permissible to receive a vaccine that has been produced unethically when an ethical alternative is not readily accessible?

In such a situation, we are guided by the Church's teaching, which directs us to differentiate among various degrees of cooperation in the evil of the act of abortion. Differentiation in degrees of the moral gravity of cooperation first pertains to the original abortion(s), then the derivation of cell lines, the process of vaccine development using these cell lines, the subsequent production and eventual sale, and finally the use of such a vaccine. With respect to someone simply receiving the vaccine, the degree of connection with the original evil act is so remote that, when there also exists a proportionately grave reason for vaccination, such as the current, urgent need to halt the COVID-19 pandemic, then the Church assures us that it is morally permissible for Catholics to receive it for the good of personal and public health.

However, this judgement must not be allowed to obscure the seriousness of the evil act that is the source of cell lines used in some vaccines, nor the corresponding ethical issues arising for those who work in research and development on them, or profit from their sale. It remains imperative that Catholics make clear their moral objection to vaccine development derived from abortion, and to advocate with their governments for ethically produced vaccines.

We address a special appeal to our Catholic brothers and sisters in the biopharmaceutical industry. Allow respect for the sanctity of human life from conception onward to find expression in work that leads to the replacement of morally illicit cell lines with ethically sourced ones. Please be assured of our prayerful support of this good and necessary endeavour.

Let us all together entrust ourselves and our world to the intercession of the Blessed Mother. May the powerful intercession of the Mother of God bring full healing to the sick, deep consolation to those who mourn, holy inspiration to researchers, and a swift end to the pandemic.

Mary, Health of the Sick, pray for us.

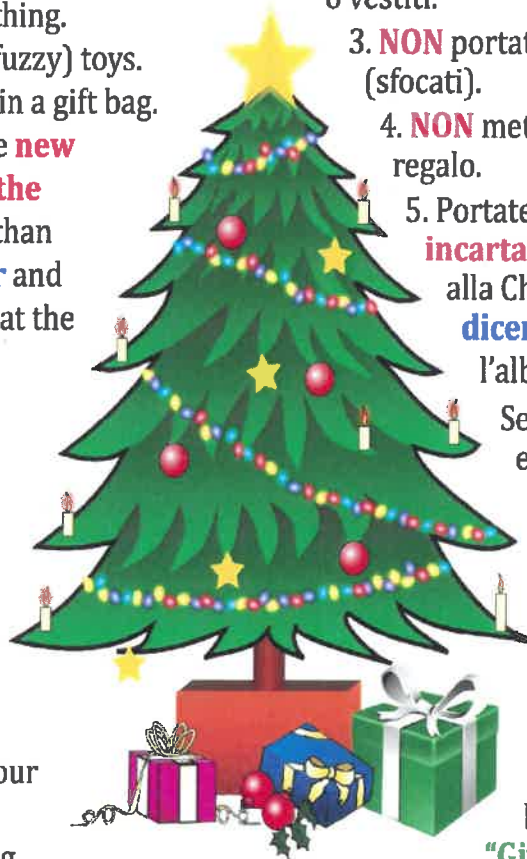
